Choose one or several of the activities below to create your own inference activities. If you would like, I can copy your creation to use as an extra activity for the next lesson!

Reflection Writing

Describe a time that you have had to use this skill of inferring. Were you watching a movie and used clues that led you to an important discovery? Was there a time that someone didn't have to say anything but you knew what happened? Record your experience to share!

Create a "Guess the..." Activity

Pick a topic such as an animal, a movie, a game, or a person. Then create clues to help describe it without stating what it is. You can list your clues or make them into a little book.

Create a Poem

Write your own poem that causes the reader to infer. Make sure to include text evidence without directly stating specific information.

Create an Illustration

Make your own illustration that causes the reader to infer. Make sure to include clues or evidence in your illustration that help the reader to make an educated guess about what is happening.

Create a Riddle

Write your own riddle, where you give clues about something without directly stating what it is.

Create a Comic

Create a comic that causes the reader to infer. Make sure to include clues or evidence in your comic that help the reader to make an educated guess about what is happening.
